
Need Community Service Hours? Volunteer with Drive-By Do-Gooders

What You'll Do


From our "base camp" in Mar Vista we fill bags with bottled water, cleaning wipes, hygiene, toilet paper, socks, protein, fruit.

Then we caravan out to DTLA's Skid Row area, where nearly 12k adults live on the streets. We serve 150, mainly the elderly and disabled on the outskirts, who can't get to services.

We give directly out of our car windows and when we see pets, we stop and give them food, water, meds, harnesses, beds, toys, etc.









Why this hand to-hand giving matters:

This personal street-level giving builds compassion and de-stigmatizes the existence of homeless adults with very few toilets, water, showers.







These kids know poverty is not a crime. Every human deserves basic essentials. Their pets, too!
